

HAITIAN EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

The Town of Lake Park is accepting donation of items to be shipped to Haiti to assist in the earthquake relief effort. Donation boxes have been placed in the lobby of Town Hall, at the Lake Park Public Library, at the Public Works Department, and in the Ship's Store at the Marina where residents and visitors can place donated items. The following is a list of suggested donation items:

- Tarps, ropes
- Working generators, gas cans
- Cooking pots
- Utensils
- New Towels and washcloths
- New blankets
- Bottled water in case (12/24 per case)
- Cleaning products
- Canned food with flip open tops
- Canned pasta meals with flip open tops
- Cereal
- Snack-type food – granola bars, etc.
- Garbage liners
- Shovels
- Buckets
- Rice, beans (in 10 – 20 lbs. bags)
- Cooking oil
- Peanut butter
- Baby food and formula
- Disposable baby diapers
- Batteries, flashlights, matches
- Gauze, Neosporin and other antibiotics
- Bar soap, tooth brushes, toothpaste, shampoo, first-aid supplies such as band-aids (unopened and sealed in one-gallon zip lock bags – separate from any food items)
- New clothes and shoes
