

RESOLUTION NO. 02-02-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TIME AND PLACE OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 8, 2005 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FOR THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA; THE FILING DATES FOR SUCH MAYROAL POSITION IS TUESDAY, JANUARY 25, 2005 THROUGH TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2005 AT 5:00 PM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. That a General Election shall be held and is hereby declared to be held in the Town of Lake Park, Palm Beach County, Florida, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the 8th day of March, 2005 for the purpose of electing A Town Mayor to the Town Commission of the Town of Lake Park.

Section 2. Tuesday, January 25, 2005 at 12:00 noon is hereby designated as the opening date for those interested in qualifying as a Mayoral Candidate for the General Election to be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2005; Tuesday, February 8, 2005 at 12:00 noon shall be the closing date for candidates to file with the Town of Lake Park for the March 8, 2005 General Election.

Section 3. At least thirty (30) days before Tuesday, February 8, 2005, but not more than forty five (45) days before Tuesday, March 8, 2005, the Town Clerk of the Town of Lake Park shall post in three (3) conspicuous places in the town, one of which shall be at the door of the Town Hall. Notice of such election and offices and what vacancies are to be posted.

Section 4. The Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections or his designee, from his office is hereby made a member of the Town's Canvassing Board, enabling him to represent the Town of Lake Part at the Logic and Accuracy (L&A) testing of the voting equipment prior to the election. The Supervisor of Elections Office is also requested to prepare absentee ballots for the Town of Lake Park, to be distributed to who are those unable to vote on the day of the General Election. The Supervisor of Elections Office is hereby requested to count the absentee ballots and include Lake Park in their canvassing advertisement.


Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.



The Mayor thereupon declared Resolution No. 03-02-05 duly passed and adopted this 2nd day of February, 2005


