

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-01-06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA APPROVING THE FORM OF AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT FOR NON-TOWN SPONSORED ORGANIZED TEAM SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES USING TOWN RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Lake Park, Florida is a duly constituted municipality having such power and authority conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission has previously adopted general provisions pertaining to the use of parks and recreational facilities within the Town of Lake Park ("Town"); and

**WHEREAS**, Town staff has recommended to the Town Commission that an application form be adopted for use by persons and/or entities wishing to use Town recreational facilities for organized team sports and activities which are not sponsored by the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the proposed permit application form with required fees and other required information to be provided by the user of the Town recreational facilities is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "**WHEREAS**" clauses are hereby incorporated herein as true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** The application form for use of Town recreational facilities for non-Town sponsored organized team sports, events and other activities, with general policy, rate schedule and other information to be provided attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted by the Town Commission as the standard permit application form. The Town Manager is hereby delegated the authority to approve changes to the permit application as may be required for certain organized team sports or activities.


**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




