The Town desires to retain a qualified firm for the design, permitting and construction administration services for Lake Shore Park and Kelsey Park Improvements which include ADA COMPLIANT RESTROOMS (two new buildings plus demolition and renovation of existing buildings) and TENNIS COURT LIGHTING. The qualified firm must include a team of specialty consultants for electrical, mechanical, civil, survey, environmental, geotechnical and construction inspection. The project budget is \$400,000.


Responses received after that time will be returned unopened.
