NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Lake Park, Florida will be accepting sealed bids for:

**DOWNTOWN ALLEYWAY IMPROVEMENTS,
7th to 8th STREET, PAVING, DRAINAGE, LIGHTING
TOWN OF LAKE PARK
Town Bid No. 106-2011**

The work shall generally consist of reconstruction of an existing 600' paved alley to improve drainage including drainage pipe and structures, base replacement, asphalt milling, asphalt paving, pavement striping, signage, dumpster enclosures, concrete curbing, electrical and lighting, fencing and miscellaneous construction. The project allows 90 calendar days for completion.

Sealed bids will be received in triplicate by the Town Clerk until 11:00 a.m., on July 26, 2011, at the Town of Lake Park, Town Hall located at 535 Park Avenue, Lake Park, Florida, 33403. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened.

Project Documents

Bid documents may be obtained by calling the Town Clerk at (561) 881-3311, 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday–Friday, upon payment of a \$40.00 non-refundable fee, for each bid set.

Bids shall be submitted on the form(s) provided.

Pre-Bid Conference

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference is scheduled for 10:00 a.m., July 14, 2011 in the Town Hall Commission Chambers, Lake Park, Florida.

Bid Documents

Envelope containing bid must be sealed and be clearly marked, "Downtown Alleyway Improvements, 7th to 8th Street, Paving, Drainage, Lighting, Bid No. 106-2011, due 11:00 a.m., July 26, 2011".

All bid prices shall be guaranteed firm for a minimum of 90 calendar days after the submission of the bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 calendar days after the bid opening date.

Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond acceptable to the Town or Cashier's Check made payable to the "Town of Lake Park" in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid will be required. The successful bidder will be required to submit a Guaranty Bond in the form of a Performance and Payment Bond in the amount equal to 100% of the contract amount. The Surety Company shall have at least the minimum ratings of A-, Class VI or higher, as described in the Instruction to Bidders.


Bids will be opened and read aloud in the Town of Lake Park Commission Chambers at 11:00 a.m. on July 26, 2011. Award of bid will be made at a Town Commission meeting.

All bidders/proposers are advised that the Town has not authorized the use of the Town seal by individuals or entities responding to Town invitations to bid or requests for proposal, and that any such use by unauthorized persons or entities constitutes a second degree misdemeanor pursuant to Section 165.043, Florida Statutes.

All bidders/proposers are advised that the Town will not supply or sell materials to bidders/proposers in connection with submission or preparation of bids, or any other matter, including but not limited to envelopes, labels or tape.

Bidders/proposers shall demonstrate successful performance of projects of a similar magnitude, scope, value and trade as this project.

The Town Commission of the Town of Lake Park reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in a bid and to make awards in the best interests of the Town.
