

**RESOLUTION NO. 18.03.06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK AND PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR THE EXCHANGE OF GEOGRAPHIC DATA AND LAND INFORMATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Lake Park (Town) is a municipal corporation of the State of Florida with such power and authority as has been conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town and Palm Beach County (County) have agreed to the exchange of geographic data and land information for the mutual benefit of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town and the County to enter into an Interlocal Agreement whereby the County's GIS Service Bureau will provide the Town with updated County geographic data and land information on an on-going basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town and the County have agreed to share and exchange their respective updated land and geographic information on an on-going basis, in accordance with the terms and provision of the Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Commission has determined that it was in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the Town and its citizens to enter into the Interlocal Agreement to exchange updated land and geographic information on an on-going basis.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE  
TOWN OF LAKE PARK:**

**SECTION 1.**

The whereas clauses are hereby incorporated as true and correct as the findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Town Commission.

**SECTION 2.**

That Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County which is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A."**

**SECTION 3.**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Commissioner Balius, who moved its adoption.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Daly, and upon being put to a roll call

vote, the vote was as follows:

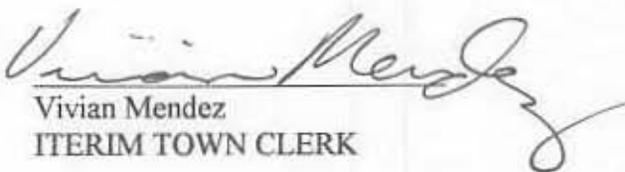
