

RESOLUTION NO. 33-07-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, REVISING THE TOWN CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE TOWN CLASSIFIED SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF AN UPDATED "CLASSIFICATION PLAN MANUAL"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, section 2-151 (1) of the Town Code provides for the preparation, maintenance, and revision of a position classification plan for all positions in Town service; and

WHEREAS, the Classification Plan is based upon similarity of duties performed and responsibilities assumed, so that the same qualifications are reasonably required for the same schedule of pay and equally applied to all positions in the same class; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide an updated listing of certain current titles and classifications within the Town services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The whereas clauses are incorporated herein as true and correct findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Town Commission.

Section 2. The Classification Plan Manual is revised to contain the position of Deputy Town Clerk, which position becomes part of the Classification Plan of the Town of Lake Park.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing RESOLUTION was offered by Vice Mayor Balius, who moved its approval. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Carey, and being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
