

**FRIENDS OF 440 HELPS
COLLEGE BOUND STUDENTS!**



The Friends of 440 Scholarship Fund has awarded scholarships for more than 21 years. The organization began in Miami-Dade, Broward and Monroe Counties awarding scholarships to four students that totaled \$12,000. Now we are a statewide organization that awards more than \$65,000 each year. Over the years we have awarded 651 scholarships totaling \$1,322,425 to students throughout Florida, helping them in their dreams of a college education.

Javier Lopez, M.D., was awarded scholarships for four years beginning in 1997. In 2001 he received a BA in microbiology and immunology from the University of Miami and in 2005 received an MD from Yale School of Medicine. He completed an internship in surgery and a residency in anesthesiology at Yale New Haven Hospital in 2009 and has since returned to South Florida where he is the Chief of Cardiothoracic Anesthesia at Kendall Regional Medical Center in Miami and also works at Aventura and Mercy Hospitals. He specializes in cardiothoracic, vascular, regional anesthesia and trauma. He was eligible for the scholarship due to a work-related injury of his father. Dr. Lopez said, "All of my work and accolades could not have been achieved had the Friends of 440 Scholarship Fund not assisted early on in my studies. I am truly grateful for the assistance your organization has provided, and I look forward to working with 440 in the future."

Narcy Fajardo, Esq., was awarded a scholarship in 2005. In 2006 she received a BBA with a double major in finance and marketing from the University of Miami. In 2009 she received a JD from St. Thomas University. After graduation she practiced in workers' compensation. She is now an attorney with Conroy, Simberg, Ganon, Krevans, et. al. in Miami specializing in PIP defense and general insurance liability defense. She was eligible for the scholarship due to a work-related injury of her father that occurred while she was at UM.



"The 440 Scholarship was significant in one particular way - the people of the scholarship sympathized with my struggle - that of having an injured dad, a sick mom, and a young college student trying to realize her dreams. Other scholarships focused on my grades as did the 440 Scholarship, but I felt as if I was not alone because the 440 Scholarship not only looked at my grades, but at my entire person, my achievements as well as my struggles."

Ms. Fajardo is a member of the statewide Board of Directors, Vice President of Fundraising for the South Florida Division, a member of the Alumni Committee, and chair of the new Mentoring Project that matches scholarship alumni with current recipients.

Greg Feldman was awarded scholarships for four years beginning in 2006. He was eligible due to a work-related injury of his father. In 2010 he received a BA in political science and economics, graduating magna cum laude from the University of Florida. In 2012 he received a Master of Public Administration (MPA) from the Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration at George Washington University, where his focus was public policy and federal management. He received a national award from Phi Sigma Kappa, his fraternity, for being one of the top undergraduates in the country. He began work in 2012 for ActioNet, which contracts with the Federal Transit Administration at the Department of Transportation. In graduate school he initiated in Pi Alpha Alpha, the National Honor Society for Public Affairs and Administration. He was treasurer of the student association for MPA students. Greg is an Eagle Scout and now loves living in Washington, DC.
