Today, the Mayor of the Town of Lake Park declared a state of emergency within the geographic boundaries of the Town of Lake Park due to the expected impact by Hurricane Matthew which provides as follows:

1. The Town Commission meeting scheduled to take place on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. is hereby postponed.
2. That all Town offices including Town Hall, the Library, the Lake Park Harbor Marina and the Public Works Department shall be closed on Thursday, October 6, 2016.
3. The curfew to be established by Palm Beach County shall be followed by residents of the Town of Lake Park.
4. The evacuation order issued by Palm Beach County shall be followed by residents of the Town of Lake Park.
5. The within declaration shall be in full force effective 5:00 p.m. on October 5, 2016, and shall remain in full force until the state of emergency declared by the Governor has been lifted.

Additionally, there will be no sanitation pick-up on Thursday, October 6, 2016 due to the expected impact of Hurricane Matthew.
