(Section 20-34)
- 3. No more than two (2) such Garage Sale Permits may be issued to one (1) single-family or duplex and/or family or household during any calendar year.
- 4. An unlimited number of signs are permitted. (Section 70-103(1)(c))
- 5. All signage must be removed by 8:00 a.m. the day immediately following the date(s) of the garage/yard sale. Signage cannot be placed on utility poles or columns, fences, or similar structures or objects. The date and address of the sale must be on the sign. (Section 70-103(1)(c))
- 6. Failure to follow the guidelines in (4) above will result in an immediate \$50 fine.
